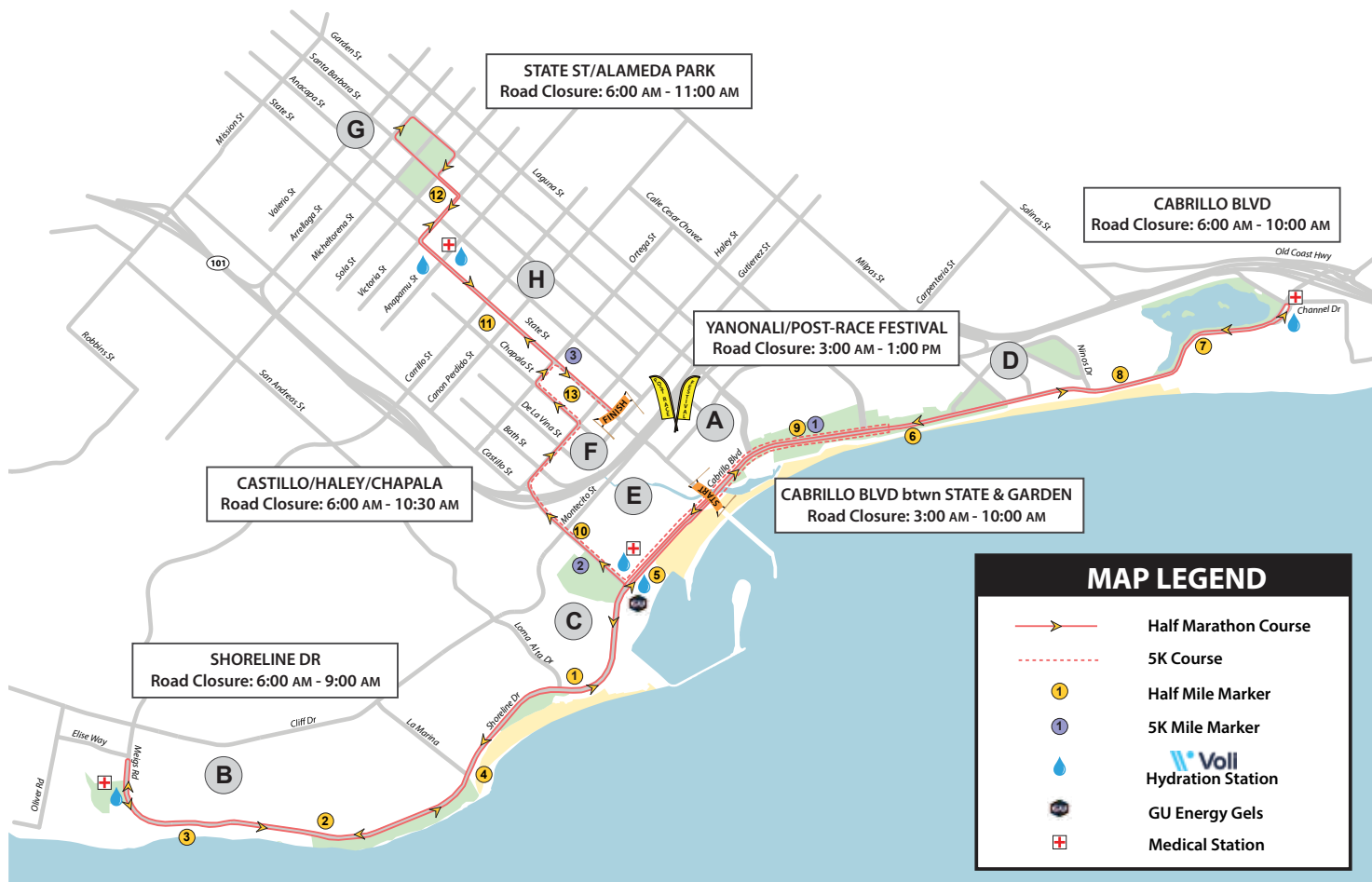


ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

THE SANTA BARBARA HALF MARATHON & 5K SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2025

The Santa Barbara Half Marathon presented by HOKA & UCLA Health 5K is celebrating its 5th anniversary with a sold-out event welcoming 7,000 runners from across California, the United States, and around the world. This must-do race on the annual running calendar not only energizes the city's waterfront and downtown streets—it also fills hotels, restaurants, and supports countless small businesses throughout Santa Barbara. Since 2021, the event has raised over \$130,000 for local youth sports-focused nonprofits and public schools, with a record-breaking \$50,000+ expected in 2025 alone. At the heart of this impact is the Santa Barbara Running Association (SBRA), the official beneficiary, which has championed the joy of movement and community connection since 1948 through year-round events and youth programs.

MAP CODE	NEIGHBORHOOD / STREETS	CLOSURE TIME	DETOUR NOTES
A	State St between Gutierrez and Mason St. Yanonali St	3:00 AM – 1:00 PM	Vehicles trying to cross the route should use Montecito St or Hwy 101 at Garden St exit/entrance to avoid delays
B	Shoreline Dr and Meigs Rd to Cliff Dr	6:00 AM – 9:00 AM	Egress for residents will be available on the westbound side of Shoreline Dr and Meigs Rd. For those wishing to return to the area during the event, vehicles will have to park on streets north of Shoreline Dr.
C	Harbor – Shoreline Dr between Castillo St and La Marina	6:00 AM – 10:00 AM	Ingress/egress to Santa Barbara Harbor is available during the event from Loma Alta Dr via Cliff Dr. Vehicles should exit Hwy 101 at Las Positas Dr or Carrillo St and then drive to Loma Alta Dr from the west on Cliff Dr as the 101 off-ramp at Castillo St will be closed. Expect Delays between 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM.
D	Cabrillo Blvd	6:00 AM – 10:00 AM	Residents on Channel Dr may exit at Cabrillo Blvd. It is suggested to exit north towards Hwy 101 or Old Cast Hwy. Westbound traffic is allowed on Cabrillo Blvd from Channel Dr to Ninos Dr. All W/B vehicles will be directed to turn north on Ninos Dr.
E	Castillo St from Cabrillo Blvd to Haley St	6:00 AM – 10:30 AM	Traffic holds will occur at Montecito St and Castillo St. Vehicles trying to cross the route should use Hwy 101 at Garden St exit/entrance avoid delays. Vehicles can also cross the route freely at Arrellaga St to the north.
F	Haley St from Castillo St to State St	6:00 AM – 10:30 AM	Ingress/egress is available for residents in the neighborhoods between Haley St and 101 via Haley St, De La Vina St, or Bath St when gaps in runners allow. Expect delays between 7:30 AM to 10:00 AM
G	Alameda Park	6:00 AM – 11:00 AM	Vehicles should use Mission St or Valerio St to cross the course. Local Access Only lanes for residents around Alameda Park will be available on portions of Sola St, Arrellaga St, and Garden St.
H	State St	6:00 AM – 11:00 AM	Vehicles can cross the course on Mission St or on Hwy 101 from Carrillo St to Garden St. No vehicle crossing will be allowed across the race course.
